



Government Ridge is the site of the legislature and associated administrative and residential buildings in the former Capital of the Northwest Territories, as well as the initial community site for the Town of Battleford. Crosby Hanna & Associates led an interdisciplinary effort at preparing an integrated site development master plan, interpretive concept, feasibility assessment and business plan for a major heritage-themed tourism attraction (now called "Battle River Settlement"), focusing on the period 1876 - 1885 (the period from the time of the Territorial Capital at Battleford to the time of the Northwest Rebellion).
