



The Mendel Sculpture Garden was designed to complement the existing Mendel Sculpture Gallery located on the South Saskatchewan River in Saskatoon. The Garden reinforces the concept of pavilion in the landscape by firmly rooting the garden to the gallery and surrounding landscape. Framed views of sculpture establish strong visual and physical connections both on and off site. The firm strove to create a variety of distinctive sculpture sites complemented by the use and manipulation of planting, shade and light, ground planes, views and existing site components.
