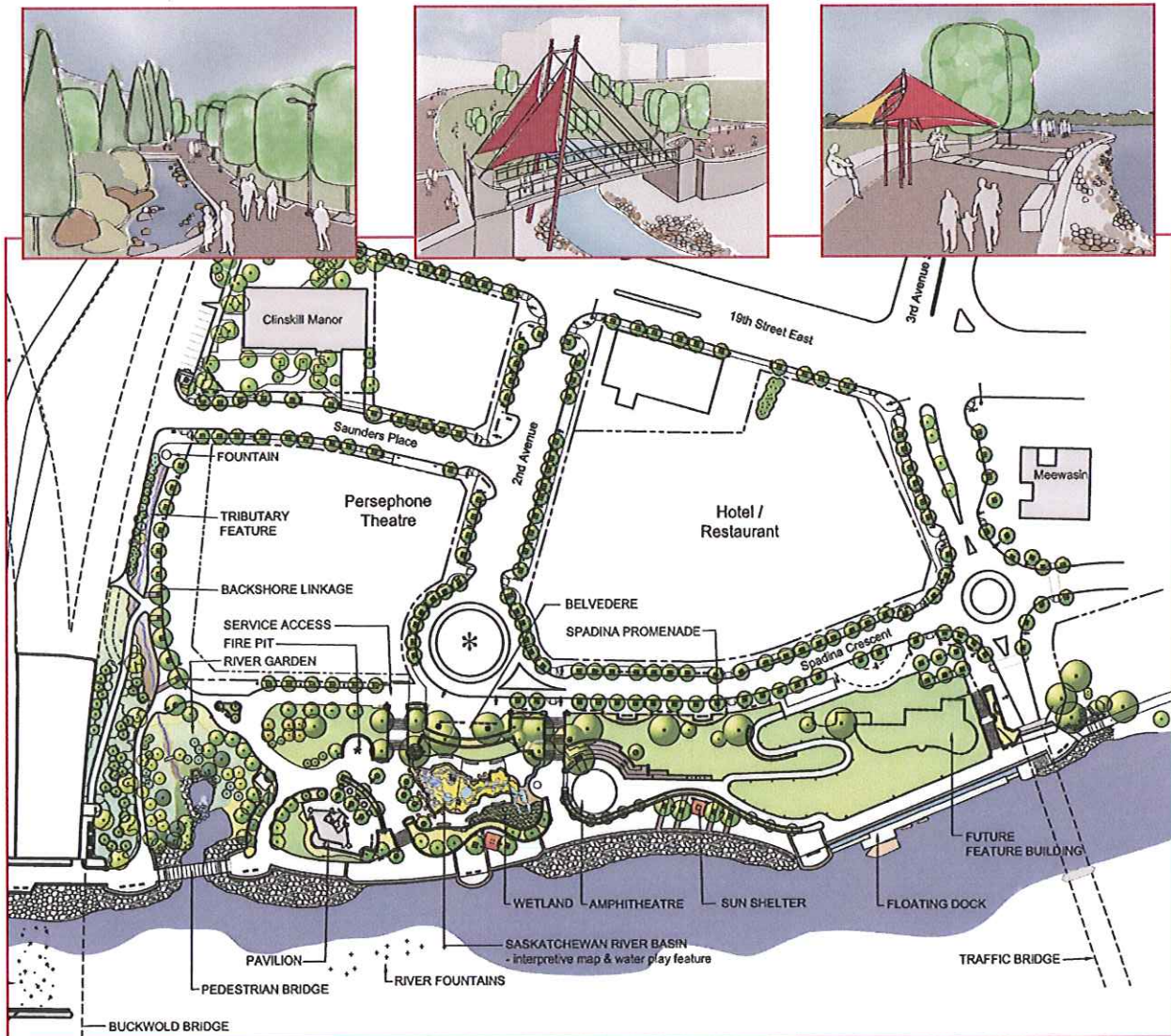


This premiere riverfront property was the subject of interest & debate since 1979. Consolidation of lands under City of Saskatoon control, strengthened by political will, resulted in the preparation of a long term Master Plan. Based on an extensive community consultation program, the plan provides the framework to transform the site into a pleasant urban riverfront which is vital, animated, safe & comfortable; a site which engages community pride & excites visitors; a site which integrates with the urban fabric & the river valley.





Intended as a complementary extension of the River Landing Phase 1 Riverfront, this project facilitates linkages along shore and backshore to integrate with adjacent land uses. Resolution of complex technical, environmental and jurisdictional approvals were required to remediate this brownfield site. Adaptive re-use of the abandoned pumphouse and the bridge promenade highlight the plan.
